GENERAL INFORMATION

PROGRAMMES & REQUIREMENTS

A. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES

1. Certificate in International Studies
2. Certificate in International Conflict Management

Admission Requirements

Common regulations governing certificate courses in the University of Nairobi shall apply

- (I) Minimum KCSE mean Grade C-OR
- (II) KCE Div. III or above; OR
- (III) 1 Principal Pass in KACE "A" Level; OR
- (IV) University Degree in any field from a recognized institution. OR
- (V) Equivalents of the above qualifications

Duration of the course

3months / 1 semester

Tuition: Minimum of 5 units.

B. ORDINARY DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

1. Diploma in International Studies
2. Diploma in Strategic Studies

Admission Requirements

A candidate must satisfy the prescribed University of Nairobi requirements. In addition, the minimum

qualifications for admission are:

- (i) KCSE C (plain), or equivalent with C(plain) in English.
- (ii) KCE Division II, or equivalent; or Division
- (iii) Evidence of relevant academic or professional training.
- (iii) 'A' level one (1) principal pass, or equivalent.

1. Diploma in International Studies /Diploma in Strategic Studies

Each Ordinary Diploma candidate shall be required to successfully take at least five (5) approved course units as well as a project paper.

Duration of the course

9 months / 2 semesters.

Tuition: Minimum No. of Units (5) Tuition per course unit (Kshs 15,000) Research Project (Kshs 20,000)

Total Tuition = 132,500.00

2. Diploma in Strategic Studies

The course is offered at (DSC) Defence Staff College for those sponsored by the Government.

C. BACHELOR OF ARTS IN INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

Admission Requirements

- (i) KCSE with a mean grade of C+ and a minimum of C in English; or
- (ii) EACE Division III and a credit pass in English and a diploma from a recognized institution; or
- (iii) KCSE C plain with a minimum of C in English and a diploma from a recognised institution; or
- (iv) KCSE with C – with a minimum of C in English and a certificate and a diploma from a recognised institution; or
- (v) "A" level certificate with at least two Principal Passes; or
- (vi) Holder of a degree from a recognised University or its equivalent

Duration of the course

4 years / 8 semesters

Minimum No. of Units 44. Tuition per course unit (Kshs 13,000) Research Project (Kshs 20,000) Non Kenyans , Add 25% to each item

D. POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

1. Postgraduate Diploma in Strategic Studies
2. Postgraduate Diploma in International Relations.

Admission Requirements

Applicants eligible for admission must:

1. Be holders of a first degree from a recognized university, or an equivalent qualification from a recognized university.
2. At least one years certified experience in relevant public service.

Postgraduate Diploma in Strategic Studies

The course will be conducted through lectures, seminars and tutorials. The students will take a minimum of seven course units, and a project paper not exceeding 30,000 words. Each course unit will be covered in 45 contact hours of study. Three units will be taught in first semester and two units in second semester. The project report will be written in the second semester
